By mobilizing leaderships and common people to work towards a better country, RenovaBR welcomes and supports Brazilians from all regions with on a common Project based on knowledge, dialog and respect to diversities. 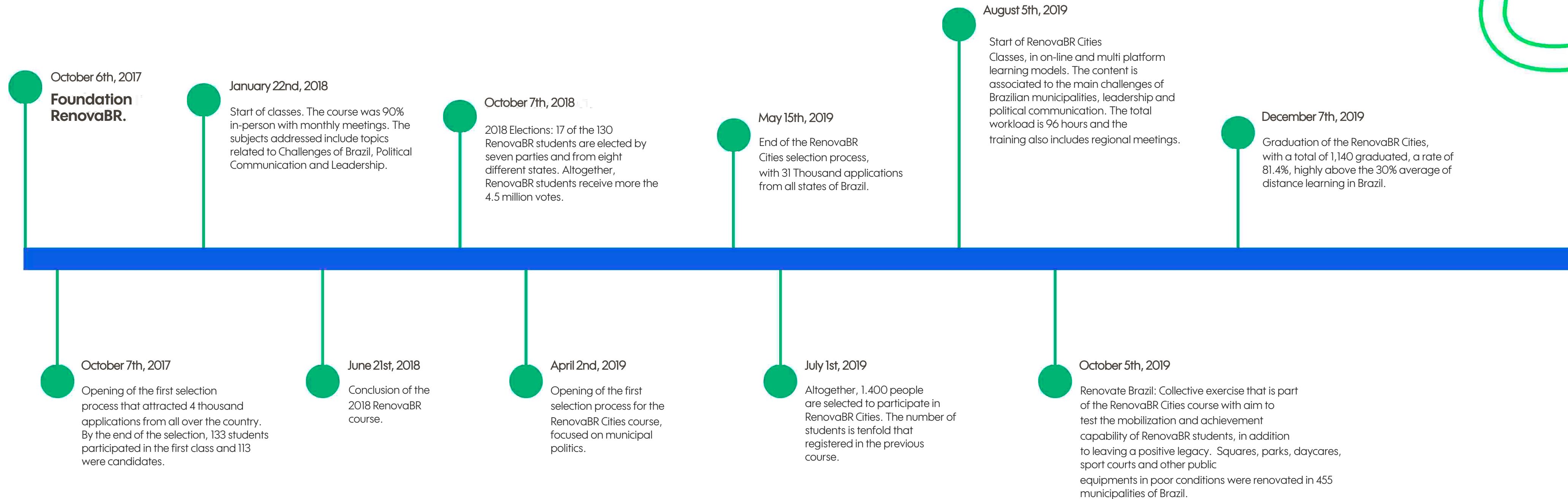

OUR HISTORY

RenovaBR is a school of democracy that transforms common people into outstanding politicians. We select and prepare Brazilians with a wide range of backgrounds, beliefs and positions to do good politics.



February 7th, 2020

Beginning of the Advanced Modules of the 2019 RenovaBR Cities course. On the weekends of days 7-9 and 14-16, RenovaBR students from all over Brazil gathered in São Paulo, to take the in-person classes of the module, focused on municipal elections elections. The 650 participants were selected among the 1,170 of the class of 2019.

March 13th, 2020

Covid-19 pandemic brings changes to the dynamics of some RenovaBR classes. Lives were broadcasted on topics related to the challenges imposed by Covid-19 and the classes were released in our Youtube channel. Everyone from RenovaBR's team started working remotely.

June 2nd, 2020

2020 RenovaBR Cities Graduation, with a total of 650 graduated students, exceeding the rate of the previous year and the average of distance learning in Brazil. The completion rate reached 92.8%.

November 15th, 2020

First round of the municipal elections in Brazil. There were 151 students elected among the 2019 and 2020 Renova BR Cities classes There were 10 mayors, 1 vice mayor and 139 city councilors in more than 123 Brazilian cities. Women's representation reached 22% and people of color, 30% in addition to belonging to more than 25 different parties.

February 9th, 2021

Opening of the selection process for the Jornada Renova, which aims to select a new class of students, but also creating an environment for the sharing of learning and self-knowledge among all those interested in transforming the reality of Brazil.

January 8th, 2020

Opening of the selection process for an extra class of RenovaBR Cities in an on-line and multiplatform learning model module. The content is related to the main challenges of Brazilian municipalities, leadership and political communication. The total workload is 96 hours.

February 16th, 2020

End of applications for the extra class. 700 students were selected to take the 2020 Renova BR Cities course, focused on the legislative and Executive powers among more than 13 thousand applications from all over Brazil.

May 15th, 2020

Renew Brazil Covid-19: collective exercise as a course conclusion activity with aim to test the mobilization and achievement capability of RenovaBR students amidst the largest and most recent sanitary crisis.

October 28th, 2020

Launch of the webseries Confirma! Sketches that address topics such as the attributions of mayors and city councilors, the impacts of municipal politics on everyday life and the dangers of fake news. There were 4 episodes with the goal of political citizenship education in face of the electoral scenario, which totaled more than 1.1M views.

November 28th, 2020

Second round of the municipal elections in Brazil. We had another 2 mayors and 1 vice mayor that participated in RenovaBR and were elected.

OUR PRINCIPLES

RenovaBR has clear principles that guide the work of all professionals in our team, teachers, suppliers and students. We respect knowledge, we base ourselves in data and evidence, we act independently, we are transparent as to our actions and face the defense of democracy as our greatest mission

KNOWLEDGE

We are a school. Our great mission is sharing knowledge. It is a precious asset, which needs to be more present in the Brazilian political debate.

We teach our students to guide themselves by data and evidence, seek reliable information and be suspicious of certainties without proof.

Representing other people and making decisions that affect their lives is an enormous responsibility. Every representative should act guided by theoretical and empirical knowledge, studying and inspiring themselves in effective public policies.

Observing what works is fundamental, including in the Search for innovation. Thus, we count on a teaching staff that is provenly experienced-experts in their áreas-and we offer content based on facts, scientific studies, successful cases and reliable sources. Respecting knowledge means having careful eyes for the diverse origins, background and experience of our students, teachers and professionals. Knowledge makes people more tolerant and empowers them to transform society.





INDEPENDENCE

We are non-partisan. Maintaining independence among political actors, agendas and demands is a key condition for our work.

That is the only way to qualify all without judging origins, beliefs, and positions. That doesn't mean political isolation, but rather establishing a broad and diverse network of interdependencies that ensure a relationship of cooperation to strengthen our actions.

A school without pre-conceived ideological bias is capable of attracting a diverse public and having access to knowledge and sharing it. We hence seek to aggregate contributions from a wide range of sectors to our repertoire, with classes and topics interesting to different groups of society.

Our independence is ensured in practice by thousands of people who donate and contribute to qualify renovation. Thinking and acting with independence creates multiple possibilities and builds better decisions.

TRANSPARENCY

We are transparent. We believe in truth as practice, beyond discourse, and we view accountability as a duty towards society.

Brazilians have extra reasons to suspect politics. It is our obligation to demonstrate we work with independence, focused in qualification and guided by democratic ideals. To be transparent is to give visibility to decisions, processes and results.

Disclosing who are our students, teachers, donors and partners. Following closely the acts of those elected.

But, above all, establishing strong bonds and frank relationships that enable renewing the confidence between society and the political class. Ethics and transparency are basic conditions for true representativity.





DEMOCRACY

We are democrats. Flying the flag of democracy means fostering dialog and respecting differences.

As a school, it is a key part of our work to train future politicians with absolute commitment with democracy.

When we qualify our representatives, we also help to strengthen the democratic ideals among the Brazilian population, and the notion that politics is essential, beneficial to society and a common ground for us all.

And it is key to have the participation, control and contribution from all sectors of society to achieve that.

Politics will only work for common people when common people are in politics.



For a long time we've been wanting to renew our politics, but elections come and it seems politics refuses being renovated by us. It's always the same names. People who know our problems all too well, are willing and capable of facing them.

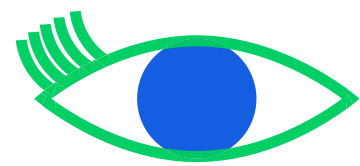
People with different positions, but who share the belief that politics is a place for honesty, dialog and dedication. RenovaBR prepares that new generation of leaderships to face and overcome old practices.

OURWORK

**RenovaBR's activities come down to two objectives:
selecting common people and training extraordinary politicians.**



SELECTION

RenovaBR knows a political leadership is not created in a classroom. Leaders have practical experiences, represent groups and concrete causes, know reality up close and seek paths to transform it. That is why it is so important to have an accurate enough selection process to find potential leaderships, with sufficient knowledge to understand the diversity of Brazil.



EXAMS

All those enrolled in the RenovaBR selection process took general knowledge and fluid reasoning tests, both developed in a way to respect the different educational backgrounds of Brazil. Also, a democratic commitment test that, as the name itself suggests, enabled us to identify if the future student understood and defended democracy, regardless of their political alignment.



VIDEO

The students that took the tests sent videos of up to two minutes where they introduced themselves, told their stories and said why they wanted to enter RenovaBR. Also, they had to describe their life situation in a S.T.A.R.* assessment model, used to identify strong and weak traits.



FINAL EVALUATION

By the end of the process, all those enrolled had their exercises assessed by two independent correctors, with opposite political positions. Afterwards, the corrections were evaluated by the RenovaBR training team to identify divergences and ensure a uniform methodology.

TRAININGS

RENOVABR ON 2020

ADVANCED MODULE

2019 RENOVABR CITIES

As part of the commitment to qualify a growing number of common people, we developed Advanced Modules for the students who took the 2019 RenovaBR Cities course.

We selected 620 students for the Advance Executive and Legislative Modules. They were chosen among those with the best performance in the class of 1,400 graduated students of 2019 and furthered their knowledge in leadership, communication and the major challenges of municipalities.

At first, we were able to provide in-person theoretical modules in São Paulo, but with the advance of the pandemic, all the training was given through video classes and interactive workshops.

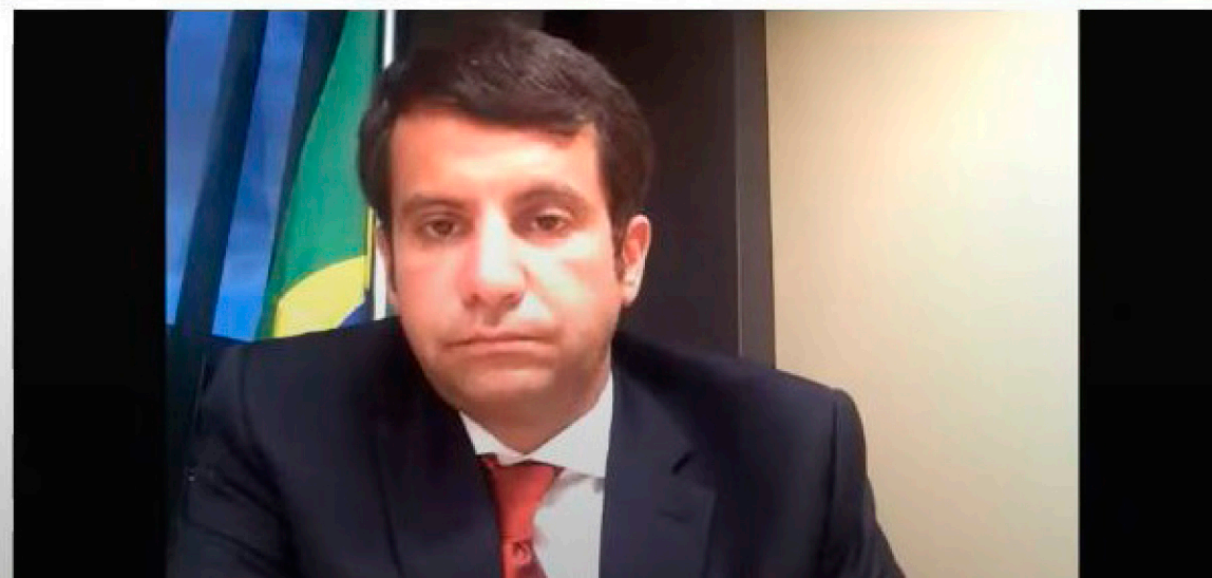
The Advanced Legislative Module had a workload of 42h divided into 25 subjects for more than 500 students. As per the Advanced Executive Module, the workload corresponded to 37h in 22 subjects for more than 120 students. All classes took place between February and June, 2020.

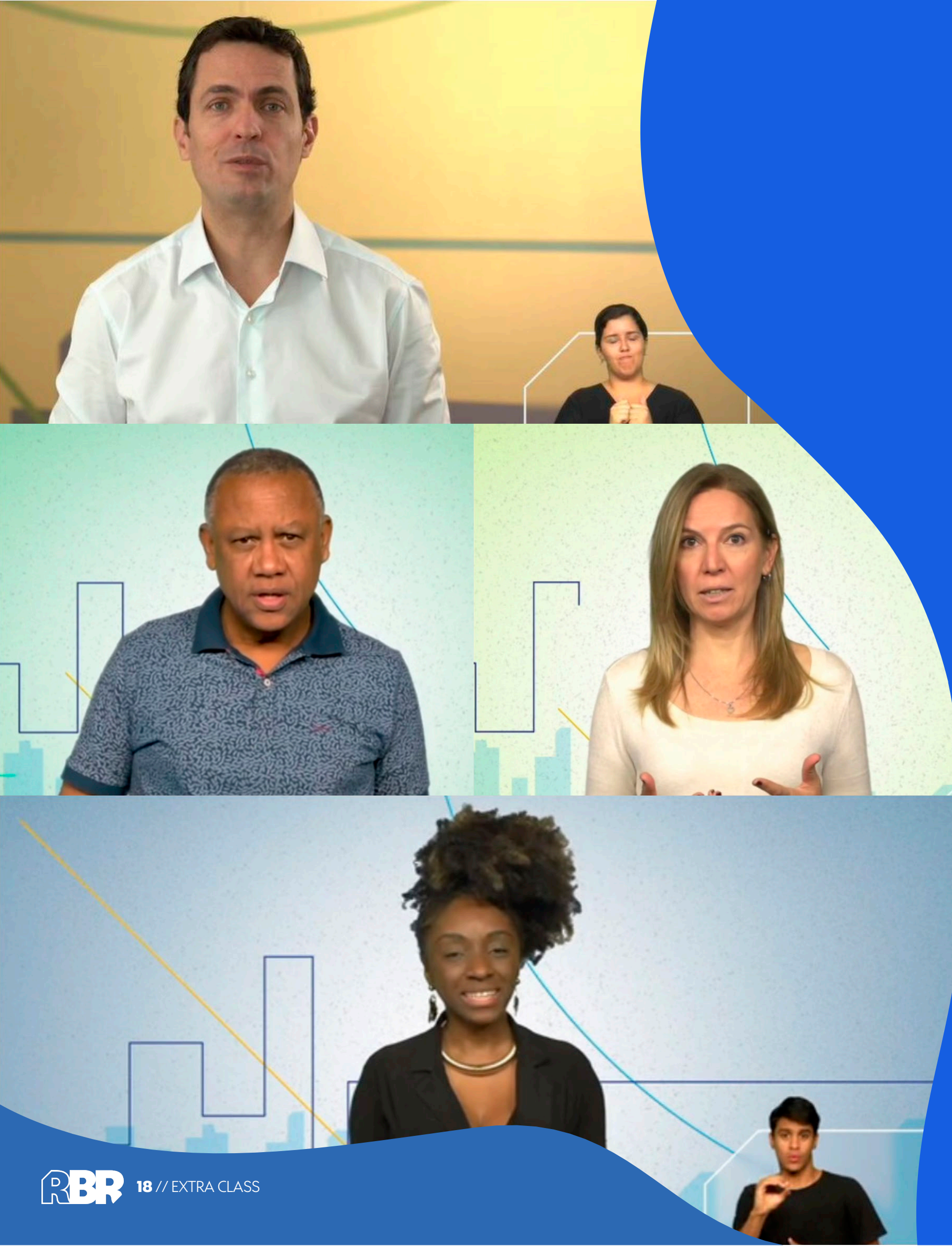


EXTENSION 2019 RENOVABR CITIES

Complementing the training for 2019 RenovaBR students who were not selected for the Executive and Legislative Modules, the school offered an extension course for 252 students.

There were 20h in video classes divided into 18 subjects with a further approach of relevant topics for the administration of Brazilian municipalities. We did lives on YouTube with guests about ethics in politics and health administration during the pandemic.





EXTRA CLASS 2020 RENOVABR CITIES

2020 RenovaBR Cities classes focused on ordinary people that wanted to run for the offices of city councilor and mayor, and also for those who wished to work in technical positions. More than 13 thousand people applied to the selection process for that class, 700 of which were approved and 648 completed the course.

In order to qualify citizens from all regions of Brazil and observing all sanitary protocols against Covid-19, the school opted for an on-line and multiplatform model learning model. Over the months, the selected students studied topics related to three pillars: challenges of municipalities, political communication and leadership.

The classes included modules such as ethics and leadership, health and public education, urban planning, land occupation, how to organize a campaign, among others. Altogether, the total workload was 96 hours - 24 hours of exercises and elective activities. Students had classes with the top specialists in Brazil - more than 40 teachers.

RENOVATING BRAZIL COVID-19

More than 700 students carried out the Renovating Brazil Covid-19 project until May 17th.

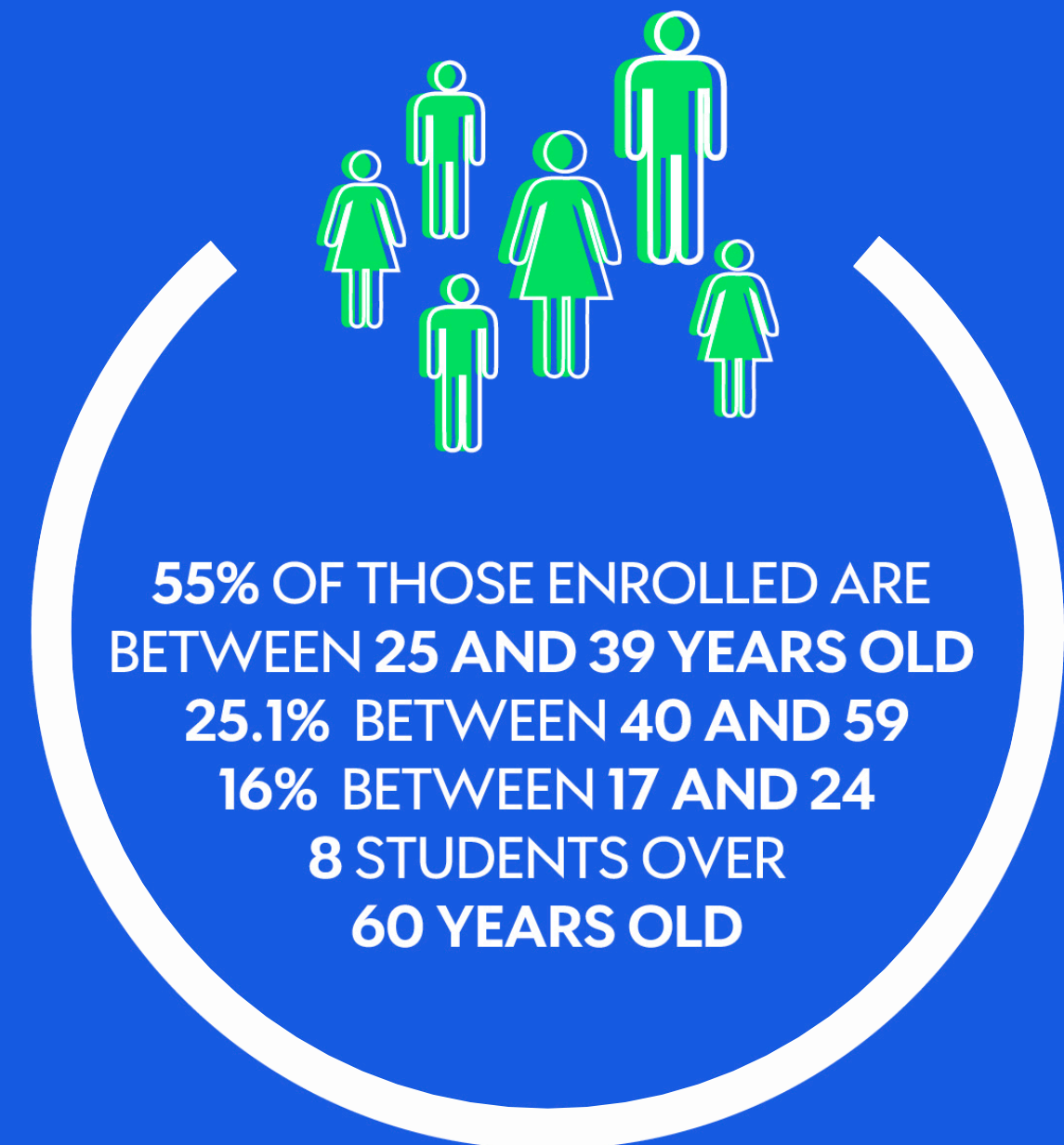
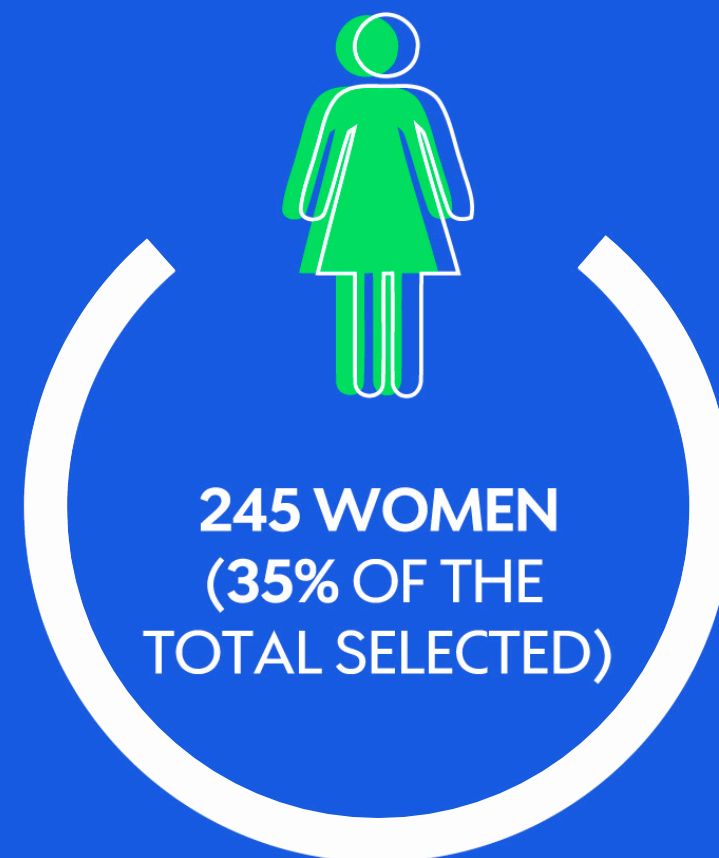
The proposal was to gather volunteers in actions with social impact during the largest sanitary crisis of our time with the evaluation of the Course Completion Work (TCC).

Beyond a mere academic paper, the students mobilized to help those most vulnerable in several actions: delivery of food packages, production and distribution of masks, acquisition of cleaning and personal hygiene materials, among others. The results impacted 900,000 people with actions in 332 cities of all regions in a major mobilization of humanitarian help.

EXEMPTION POLICY

Upon enrollment in the course, the 700 students selected for the 2020 RenovaBR Cities made a Commitment Deposit, in the amount of R\$ 200. In order for the school to encourage the ingress of low income candidates in all of its trainings, RenovaBR created an Exemption Policy.

The 69 students that received the exemption of 100% of the value in 2020 were within the established conditions required: they were approved in all prior stages of the selection process and did not have financial conditions to afford the training.

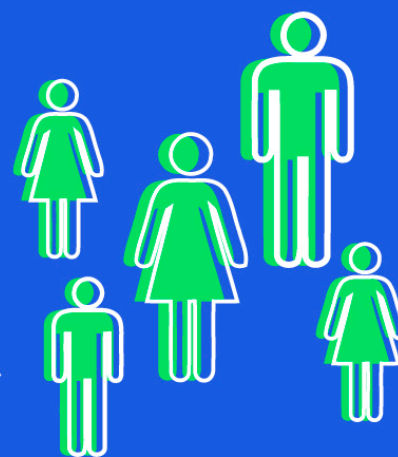
The process was conducted by the institution's Selection and Diversity sectors. At the end of the course, the students that concluded all stages and graduated were able to request the refund of the Commitment Deposit. However, 397 students chose to donate the value to the school as a means to contribute towards the training of new political leaderships.

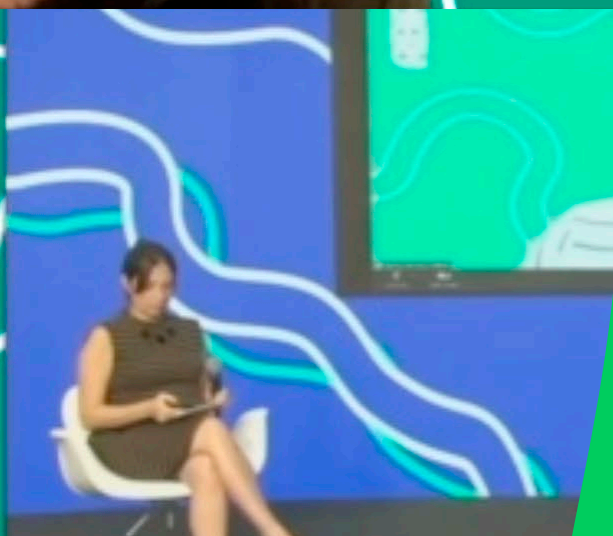
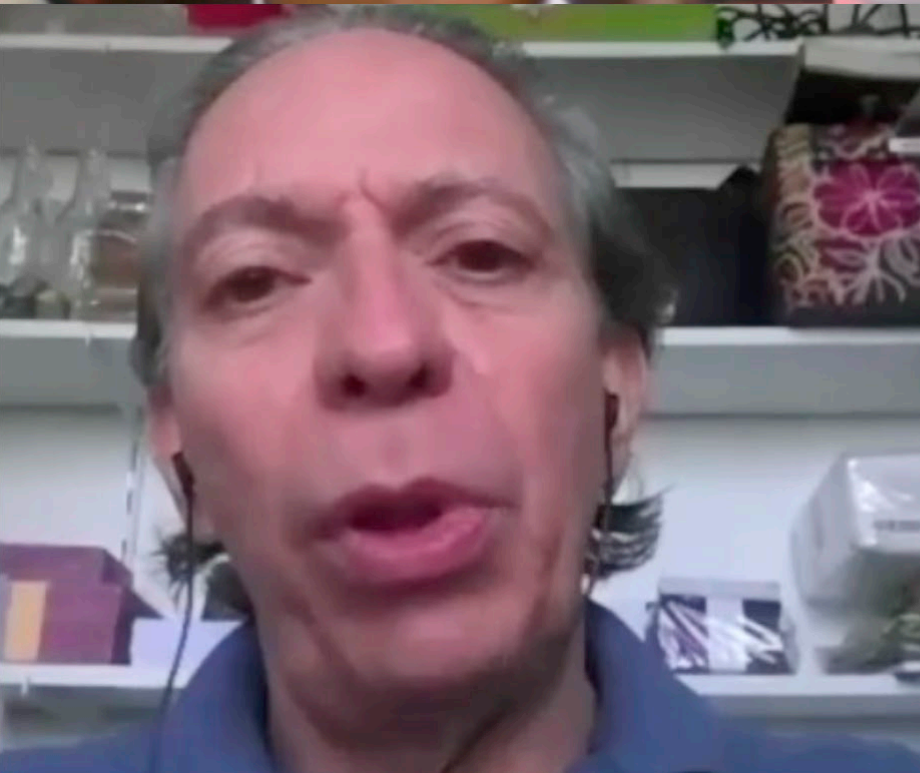
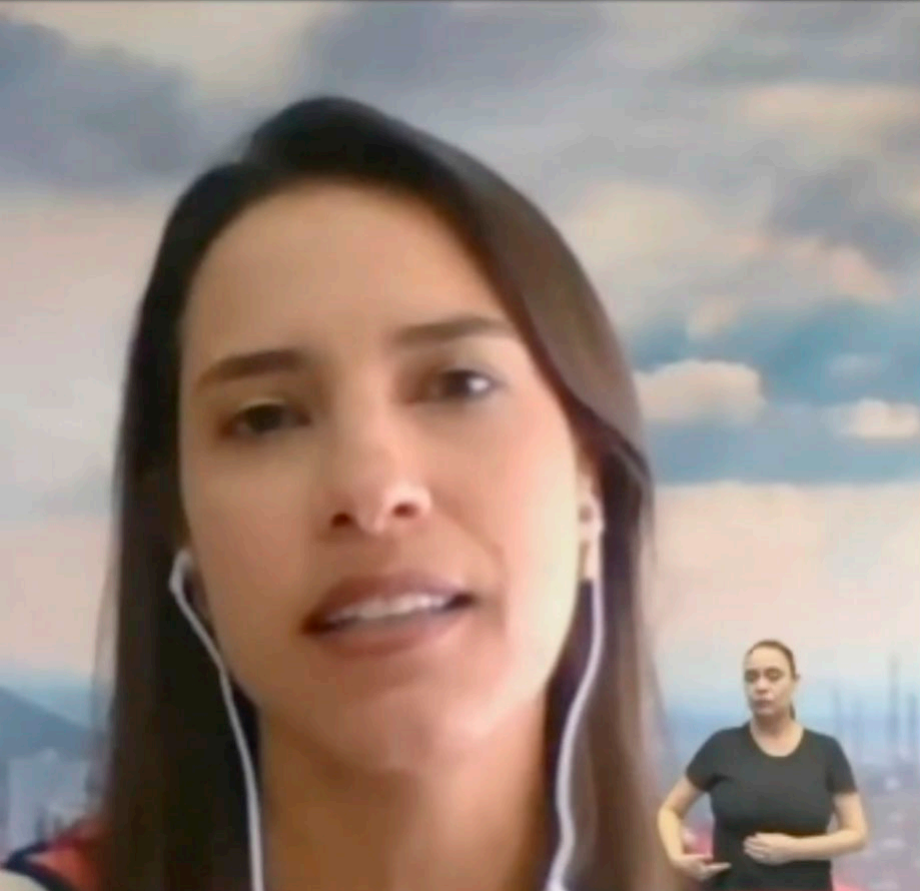

CONTINUED TRAININGS IN 2020



CONTINUED TRAINING MUNICIPAL EXECUTIVE AND LEGISLATIVE

After the impact of electing 174 students for the offices in Municipal Executive or Legislative offices in November 2020, RenovaBR continued preparing their students to assume mandates as of January 2021, particularly due to the challenges imposed by the Covid-19 pandemic.

Still in November, we started the courses 'Administration of Municipal Mandates' intended for the mayors, vice mayors, and city councilors elected.

With a workload of 26h, the courses had the goal of presenting those elected with the factors for success of a municipal mandate; the specifications of city councilors works; the importance of a project for political leadership; the importance of socio-emotional skills; and also the moments of the municipal mandate cycle.

CONTINUED TRAINING

Beyond the training directed to the students that ran for electoral offices, RenovaBR continues to offer continued formation for those elected. After the course conclusion in 2018, the 17 former students elected are receiving monthly content on the administration of a mandate and relevant issues of the National Congress.

In 2020, the courses were all structured in a format of on-line workshops due to the restrictions imposed by the Covid-19 pandemic. There were 29h of training with a highlight to the topics of Crisis Management, The Economic Impact of the Pandemic, Post Pandemic Proposal Agenda, Assessment of the Administrative and Tributary Reform Proposals, Regulation of the New FUNDEB and Minimum Wage.

Open to all congress members, the workshop had the participation of house representatives and staff members of the 17 students elected in 2018, as well as other Senators and Federal Representatives that share RenovaBR's values.

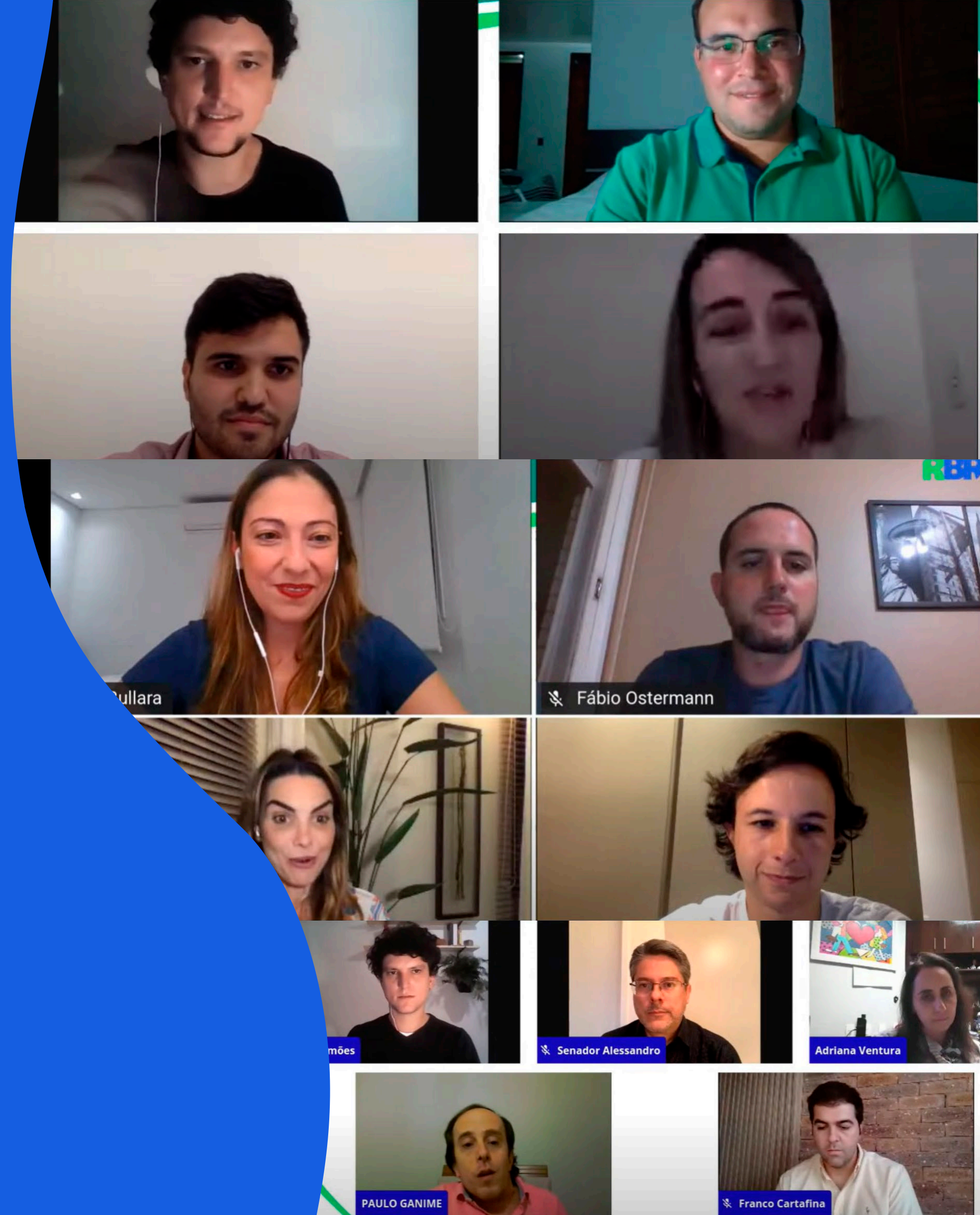

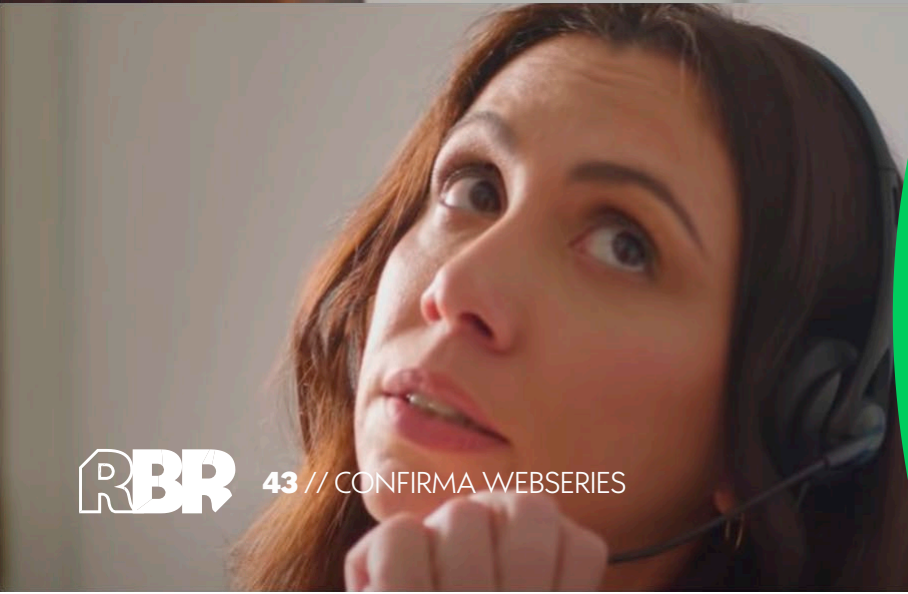

With the goal of helping common citizens to understand municipal elections in a light and fun way, we launched the Confirma! webseries on our YouTube channel to address issues such as the attributions of mayors and city councilors, the choice of the most prepared candidates and the identification of fake news that may affect results at the ballots.

In the first episode, "Bom Partido", the couple Nat and Julio decides to search for the perfect candidate via an app, but soon realizes the promises of some city councilors are outside the scope of their attributions.

In the next video, "O Idiota", the talk is directly with the voter and the role he has in renovating politics. Vini explains to Ivan, his childhood friend, the importance of knowing both the proposals and past lives of the candidates.

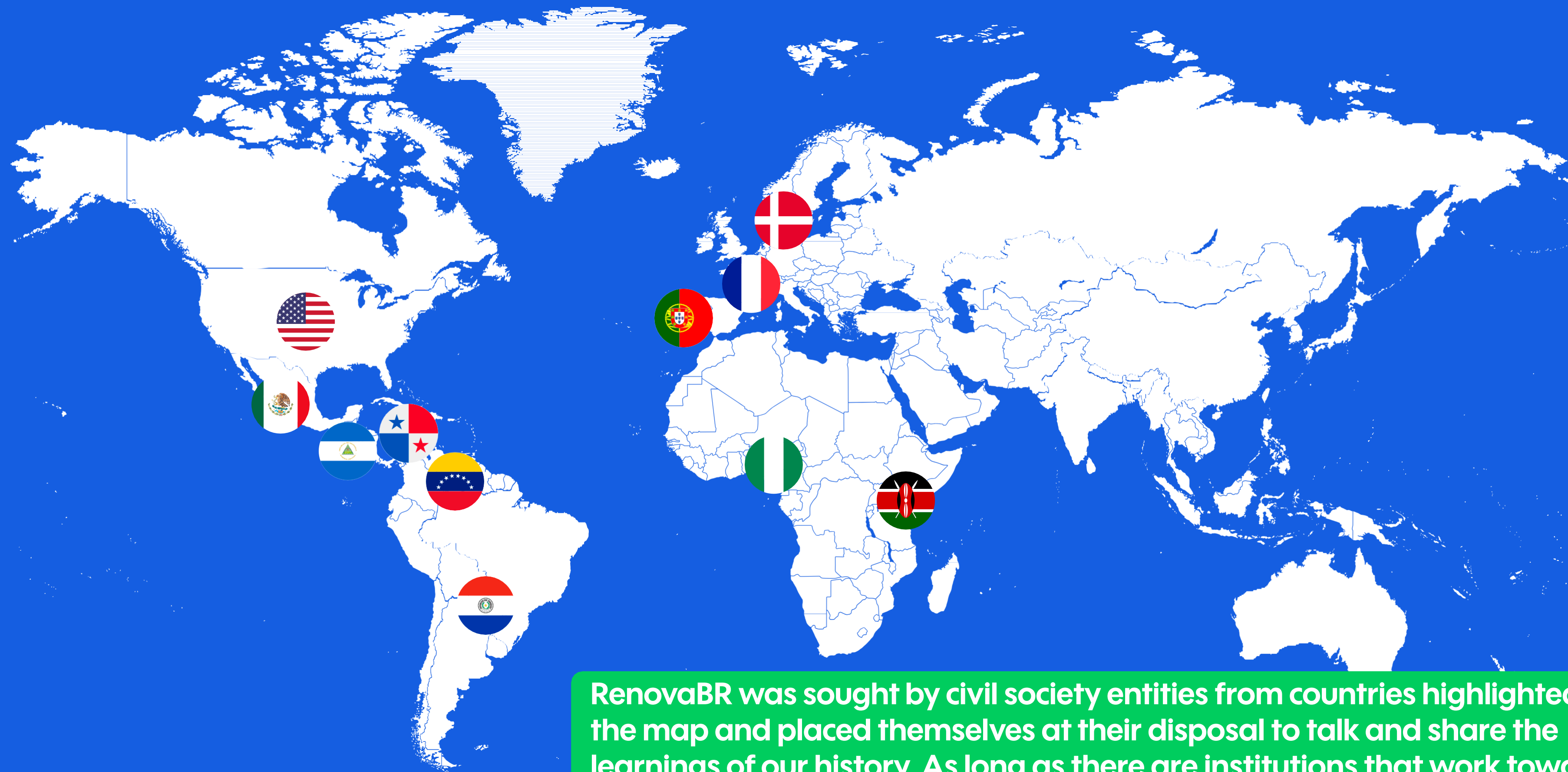
